The Supply Chain Manager will own and be responsible for developing people, processes, and implementing systems to manage the organizations' GMP demand/supply network while developing and implementing processes for various projects across the company. The responsibilities of primary importance are to ensure the successful and time-sensitive planning, tracking and communication relating to CMC and Supply Chain activities.

**Responsibilities:**

- Develop and monitor forecasts to identify changes or determine their effect on inbound materials and outbound finished goods.
- Manage and coordinate material planning, inventory control, storage, shipping, and receiving functions.
- Direct and monitor inbound and outbound shipments of raw materials and finished goods.
- Analyze raw material, and finished goods inventories to improve production efficiency, increase inventory turns or reduce waste.
- Define performance metrics for measurement comparison or evaluation of supply chain factors such as product cost or quality.
- Identify project issues and facilitate resolution, conduct risk management and contingency planning
- Responsible for the overall direction of work coordination and evaluation of the materials management and Supply Chain process.
